GENERAL ANALYSIS & WRITTEN FEEDBACK

General views on the evening, based on tickbox exercise

- All parents present agreed that the evening provided them with a good idea of what was coming up that term and across the year in general;
- Almost all parents left the evening knowing what the school's expectations were of their child(ren), how to help them at home and with an understanding of what their child(ren) would be taught in their respective year groups;
- Every parent present understood the importance of good behaviour and almost every parent understood the importance of prompt arrival and excellent attendance;
- Almost all parents felt that staff were/are approachable;
- Every parent found the evening to be beneficial.

How could the school improve this evening for next year?

- More time in classroom with teachers and Rebbes;
- More sessions for parents with more than one child (note; there are 4 sessions available across two evenings but we will look into splitting this across 3 evenings next year);
- Start on time (commitment already made to parents since Curriculum Evening that all future events will start on time);
- Don't improve anything as nothing to improve - keep the format the same;
- Don't change anything – was excellent and same again next time please;
- To have direct contact details for teachers (this is not school policy. Contact should be made via phone/email with school office and teachers will follow up from there within 24 hours).

How do you feel the school could help parents to be even better informed about the curriculum?

- Even more information meetings than there already are;
- Ask parents what other things they would like, to further improve links between teachers and parents;
- Send overview sheet home (Curriculum Information Sheets given to parents at the evening).
