Science:

Forces and Magnets – Year 3 will be exploring what forces are and notice that some forces require contact between two objects. We will also conduct an experiment where we'll compare how a toy car moves on different surfaces. In addition to that, we will learn how magnetic forces work, identify magnetic material and investigate uses for magnets.

Nutrition and our body – The boys will be learning about healthy eating, the different food groups and how they help our body. They will also learn about the skeleton and muscles.

This term the students will continue their yearlong swimming lessons which will take place once a week at a local swim club. In addition to swimming, we will begin to have PE once every 3 weeks (starting in Spring 2).
