

Science:

Animals - including humans

- Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults
- Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)
- describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene

Maths

- Counting on and back in 2s 3s, 5s and 10s
- Partitioning into tens and units
- + and -, doubling and halving, and understanding the inverse
- Number pairs to 20 and beyond
- Fractions
- Position and direction
- 2D and 3D shapes
- Handling data and measuring (inc. time)
- Solving word and real life problems
- Weekly times tables (2, 5 and 10)

English

Through the teaching of the following texts 'Katie and The Starry Night' and 'Rosie Revere the Engineer' the boys will be learning:

- to use Year 2 grammar terminology, classifying words into groups such as verbs
- to distinguish between present and past tense
- to be able to write sentences using the past tense
- to discuss texts and make inferences based on the text
- to compose questions and use ? accurately
- to use adjectives and nouns for description.

The boys will continue to have weekly dictation, handwriting and guided reading.
